WALL MOUNTING: Angled-Impaling Clip (AF2)



APPLICATION:

For mounting fiberglass acoustical wall panels.

DESCRIPTON:

This installation technique uses Angled-Impaling Clips to mount fiberglass acoustical wall panels. Installation is completed in the following order:


- 1. Lay out panel location on the wall.
- Fasten AF2-Impaling Clips to the wall 48" O.C. with the points facing up. Note: If panel dimension is less than 48", space clips evenly.
- 3. Attach panels by pressing down toward the wall so points imbed firmly in the back of the panel.
- 4. This installation technique will leave a 1.25" reveal between the ceiling and the top of the panel.
- 5. Use the following guide to determine the number of AF2-Impaling Clips to be used per panel:

Panel Size	Number of AF2-Clips
Up to 8 sf	2
9 sf to 16 sf	4
17 sf to 32 sf	6
33 sf to 60 sf	8


Horizontal panels greater than 4' wide and less than 8 SF use 3 clips.

Note: Due to variations in fiberglass thickness and wall inconsistencies, some shimming may be required to align the panel edges.
